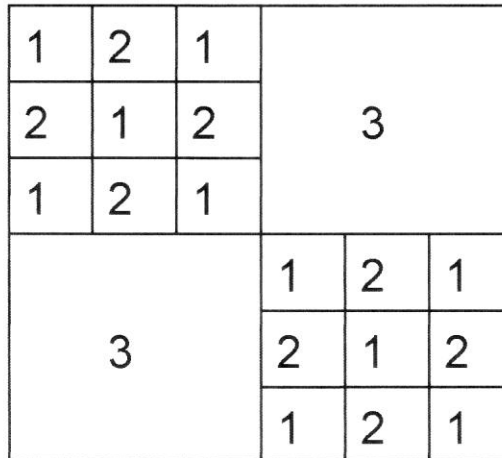


Block of the Month – September 2009

My First Quilt Block

Unfinished 12 ½"



Fabric needed:

Color #1 & 2: Two medium to dark earth-tone colors for 9-patch (greens, browns, golds)

Color #3: (Background) : light earth-tone solid or looks like solid (green, tan, gold)

Cut the following:

9-Patch:

Color #1: □ Cut 10 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

Color #2: □ Cut 8 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

Color #3 (Background): □ Cut 2 – 6 ½" x 6 ½" squares

Directions: Refer to diagram for fabric placement.

Using a ¼" seam allowance, assemble the 2 ½" blocks together to form rows, press seams toward the #2 color. Then sew the rows together to form 2 – 9-patch blocks.

Sew a background square to each 9-patch, press toward the background. Then join these two segments to finish your "My First Quilt Block".
